

ADMISSION POLICY

Our College Principal constitutes an admission/counselling Committee and all the admissions are made by the college through committee strictly in accordance with the affiliated university rules. Before the start of academic session an admission policy is framed by the admission committee.

Pre- Registration – More emphasis is given to the rural admissions (as it was the dream of our founder Sant Pt. Nischal Singh ji Maharaj). So, teams of teachers are deputed to visit different villages (with in radius of 50 km) and convince the parents to send their girls to pursue higher education. Teachers also motivate the girls and make them aware about the different courses being run in the college. Buses ply in these rural areas to help the students to visit the college.

Special incentives are given to students from rural areas.

Teachers also visit different schools and council students of 10+2 about various streams.

Principals of different schools are contacted and pamphlets giving information about different courses are distributed.

Counselling starts in summer vacations. The counselling committee comprises of members of different faculties, who help the students to select the subjects/streams. The duties are rotated every week.

Registration: Registration process starts in summer vacations, teachers on duty help the students visiting the college campus to get prospectus, fill form and get registered.

Offline admission: Being a minority college, our college carries opt for off-line admissions. As per the directions of DGHE about admission dates, registered students are contacted to take admissions.

Our college has started own online portal on our college website for admissions due to prevalence of Covid - 19 this year.

Admission of Old students/Renewal: Old students of 2nd year & 3rd year have to take fresh admission every year.

Re admission: If a student remains absent from her classes for ^{is} continuous period of 7 working days without any valid reason, medical or otherwise her name shall be struck off the rolls irrespective of the fact that she has paid her dues and she ^{has} have to pay Rs 500/- as re admission fee.

Documents to be submitted at the time of Admission: (Annexure -4)

Eligibility is checked by the members of Admission committee at the time of admission and it is insured that the candidate is eligible.

Eligibility for foreign students:

Foreign students have to obtain eligibility certificate from university before taking admission. These students have to submit documents mentioned in annexure 4 at the time of admission.

Allocation of Seats:

Admission of students does not exceed the sanctioned strength of each course. A copy of details showing sanctioned seats of each course is given in the prospectus.

Scholarships:

The college provides many scholarships to the needy and intelligent students so they can complete their studies without Problem.


