Policy for Energy Conservation

Reduce energy consumption and improve energy efficiency on campus. The following policy is adopted. This policy will be reviewed and updated periodically

- Replaced lights with LED lamps or the most energy efficient option available. They
 consume less power and last for longer periods of time.
- Limit the use of artificial lightning to those areas that are not sufficiently lighted.
- Switch of the lights and fans in room, lecture halls, labs, corridors and stairs if not in use.
- Also switch off and plug out all equipments and computers when not in use.
- Put computers in hibernation mode while taking a break.
- Buy energy efficient devices and use energy saving features of all devices.
- Print only when necessary and avoid printing files that can be sent via mail. It also reduces paper wastage.
- Renewable resources: Install solar panels. Aside from being a great source of renewable energy, solar panels are clean, long lasting and require little maintenance.
- Encourage a culture of conservation on campus and spread awareness among the students and staff about why it is important.
- Evaluate overall energy efficiency by doing energy audits.
