Policy regarding award of Non-Government Scholarships & Freeships

The institute awards scholarships to the poor, needy and meritorious students. Apart from the scholarships from government agencies, some non-government agencies also provide scholarships. Freeships are also provided to the needy students in the form of fee concession and free roadways bus passes. A number of Scholarships like Sita Ram Jindal Scholarship, Hope Foundation, Staff Fund Scholarships help the students to achieve their academic goals.

1. Staff Fund Scholarship

Criteria

- a) General category students & financially poor students are given preference.
- b) This scholarship is generally given to the second year and final year students.
- c) Fatherless students are given priority.
- d) Funds collected from the permanent staff members are distributed equally among the students from Arts, Commerce and Science Faculty.
- e) Applications are invited from the students. These applications are scrutinized by the heads of the respective departments & handed over to the scholarship in-charge (Mrs. Narender Pal Kaur, H.O.D, Department of Physics)
- f) Scholarship amount is appx Rs. 2000 per year for the fatherless students & appx Rs. 1500 for the other students.

2. Hope Foundation Scholarship

Criteria

This scholarship is provided to the students from economically weaker section, selected by the management of the college. Generally, 10-15 students are selected per year for this scholarship.

3. Sita Ram Jindal Scholarship

Criteria

- a) Only general category students can apply for this scholarship. (SC, BC or minority category students can not apply for it.)
- b) The parental income of the applicants should be less than or equal to 2.5 lakhs per annum.
- c) The applicant should have scored minimum 60% marks in 12th class.
- d) This scholarship is also given to PG students, with minimum 60 % marks in graduation.

4. Fee Concession/Freeships provided by the Institute

In addition to the above mentioned scholarships, fee concession/ freeship is also given to the meritorious students from economically weaker section (EWS) category. The amount of fee concession is generally from Rs. 1000 to Rs. 8000 which is waived off from their program fee at the time of admission by college administration. There is a provision of freeship under special circumstances.
